DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION

Our tutoring and homework assistance sessions run from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesdays, commencing September 21, 2019. The program is open to fifth- through eighth-grade students. Tutoring and homework assistance is held in the church building, and we kindly ask that you try to get your child here on time so s/he can benefit from the maximum use of the allotted time for each session.

Fall 2019 Tutoring and Homework Assistance Dates:

September 17, 24 October 1, 8, 15, 22, 29 November 5, 12, 19 December 3, 10, 17

Your child **does not** need to attend every tutoring and homework assistance session in order to remain enrolled. You must make arrangements to pick up your child by 6:30 p.m. on Tuesdays. Three late pickups, without notice, will result in termination from the program.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Student expectations are outlined in the enrollment packet. It is our aim to ensure every student has a safe, fun, and enjoyable time at our tutoring and homework assistance sessions. Students who do not meet the expectations will suffer the following consequences:

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: Time Out & Call Home

3rd Offense: Note/letter to parent/guardian advising of the student's dismissal from the

program.

TUTORS

All tutors are members of the Church of the Good Shepherd. Each tutor will utilize various types of instruction, including small group, one-on-one, and hands on activities. We will assess your child during the first week of tutoring and homework assistance, monitor his/her progress, and provide you with information regarding his/her progress.

If a tutor will be absent from or late for a session, or if a session needs to be cancelled for any reason, the parent/guardian will be promptly informed.
